5 easy rules to remember

1 Ask first



Ask a parent, teacher, or trusted grown-up before chatting, clicking, or using a new app.

2 Keep it private



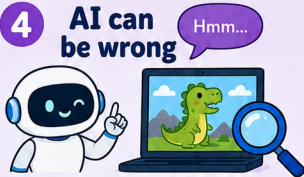
Keep your full name, address, school, passwords, and private photos private.

3 Be careful



Don't talk to strangers online and don't click strange links.

4 AI can be wrong



AI can make mistakes or tricks. Check with a grown-up.

5 Tell someone



If something feels scary, confusing, or yucky, stop and tell a trusted adult right away.
